## NONPROFIT AND FOR-PROFIT HIGHER EDUCATION AND ACCREDITATION

(Data provided to CHEA by accrediting organizations for accrediting activity during 2010-2011 as reported in 2011 CHEA Almanac of External Quality Review. Includes both Title IV and Non-Title IV Institutions.)

#### **ACCREDITING ORGANIZATIONS**

**Fourteen** of the **18** recognized institutional accreditors review both nonprofit and for-profit institutions: **seven** regional accreditors and **seven** national career-related accreditors.\*

#### Regional organizations accredited 3,050 institutions in 2010-2011

- 2,944 nonprofit institutions: all degree-granting.
- 106 for-profit institutions: all degree-granting.

#### National career-related organizations accredited 4,298 institutions in 2010-2011

- 497 nonprofit institutions: 181 degree-granting and 316 non-degree-granting. (276 institutions are public.)
- 3,801 for-profit institutions: 1,221 degree-granting and 2,580 non-degree granting.
